Our Lady of Fatima- October 13

On September 13, before a crowd of about 25 to 30,000 people, the Mother of God told the children to continue saying the Rosary "to obtain the end of the war. In October, Our Lord will also come, as well as Our Lady of Sorrows and Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and Saint Joseph with the Child Jesus, to bless the world." Then, in answer to many requests to be healed and in order that the reality of the apparitions might be made known to all, the Blessed Virgin announced that the next month she would work a great miracle. Before returning to Heaven, she declared: "In October, I will perform a miracle for all to believe."

The last apparition of Our Lady in Fatima thus took place on October 13, 1917.

1st Friday: Benediction and Sacred Heart devotions after 6:00 PM Mass

1st Saturday: Rosary and Fatima devotions after 8:00 AM Mass

2nd Sunday: Blessing of religious articles.

3rd Sunday: Breakfast to benefit the church. *Confessions after Mass on Saturdays.*
